Instructions to the Candidates

1. There will be three components in the selection process: Entrance Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview.
2. Entrance Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be conducted online.
3. It is mandatory to attend all the three components.
4. **Failure to attend any of these components will automatically lead to disqualification.**
5. The aggregate score for the three components is 100 and will be distributed as follows:
 - Entrance Test: 25
 - Group Discussion: 35
 - Personal Interview: 40
6. **Entrance test will be conducted online on 16/10/2020 from 11am -12 Noon**
7. Questions for the Entrance Test will be from:
 - Social Work (25%)
 - English (25%)
 - General Knowledge (25%)
 - Logical Reasoning (25%)
8. There will be 100 questions in the entrance test, each question carries one mark and 25% of the mark secured by the candidate will be taken to calculate the aggregate score.
9. Duration for the entrance test will be one hour.
10. The details of group discussion and interview will be informed to the candidates after the entrance test.

- Date and time of the entrance test: 16/10/2020, 11am to 11:30am.
- Candidates should log in 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- There will be a mock test at 3pm on 15/10/2020.

- Username and password (same for both tests) will be sent by SMS by 1pm on 15/10/2020.
- Kindly note the change in the total number of questions for the entrance test and its distribution.
- There will be 60 questions and each question carries 1 marks. The weightage for the online test is 25. The marks secured by the candidate for the online test is taken along with group discussion and personal interview to calculate the aggregate score in 100.

- The test is being conducted via the internet and it requires internet access throughout the examination. Kindly ensure that you have good internet connectivity (speed over 512 kbps) while taking the examination.
- Choose a separate room if possible while taking the examination. If no separate room is available, kindly make sure you choose a corner with no external disturbances and sufficient lighting during the examination.
- If the test window fails during examination, it will resume from the same instance where it had left off. Do not panic during such events.
