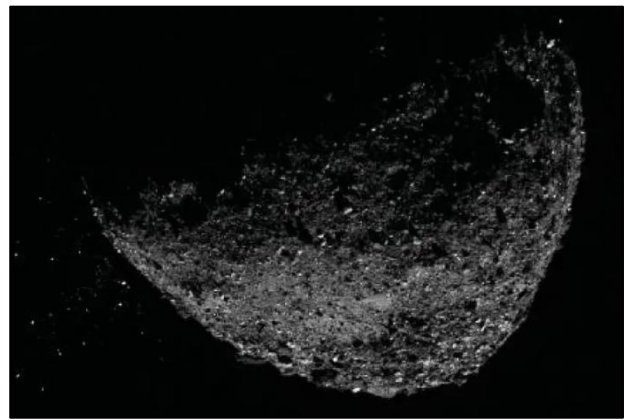

According to a recent update by NASA's asteroid tracking system, there will be five near-earth asteroid flybys this week. The US space agency revealed that the flybys began on September 11 and will last until September 18. According to an India Today report, an asteroid headed toward Earth this week is bigger than the Statue of Unity.

NASA requests proposals for 2nd moon lander for Artemis astronauts.

NASA is asking private industry to come up with ideas for another astronaut moon lander. The space agency is working to establish a long-term human presence on and around the moon by the end of the 2020s, via a program called Artemis. In 2021, NASA announced that it had selected SpaceX's Star ship as the lander for the program's first crewed surface mission, Artemis 3, which is scheduled to touch down near the lunar south pole in

2025 or 2026. Though SpaceX apparently won't be allowed to bid for the new contract, NASA wants Starship to be part of the Artemis program over the long haul.

Extinct species that lived amongst dinosaurs discovered after 150m years.

The reptile is described by scientists as *Opisthiamimus gregori* and is named after Natural History Museum volunteer Joseph Gregor, who caught the scientists' eye after he spent hours scraping the bones from a block of stone. Its closest living relative was found to be the tuatara, which inhabits New Zealand. The tuatara looks similar to an iguana but is not actually a lizard. The research claims the reptile measured 16 inches from nose to tail and likely survived mostly on a diet of insects.

University Of Minnesota geologists discover major meteor crash site.

(September 16, 2022)

Only 190 meteor impact sites have been confirmed worldwide, but a recent discovery by U of M researchers could soon add an ancient crater in Minnesota to that list. The crater lies an average of 350 feet beneath Inver Grove Heights, a suburb on the Mississippi River, and appears to be at least 4 kilometers—2.5 miles—across. That means it should have an area 11 times the size of Meteor Crater, the iconic surface crater in Arizona, which measures 0.74 miles across.

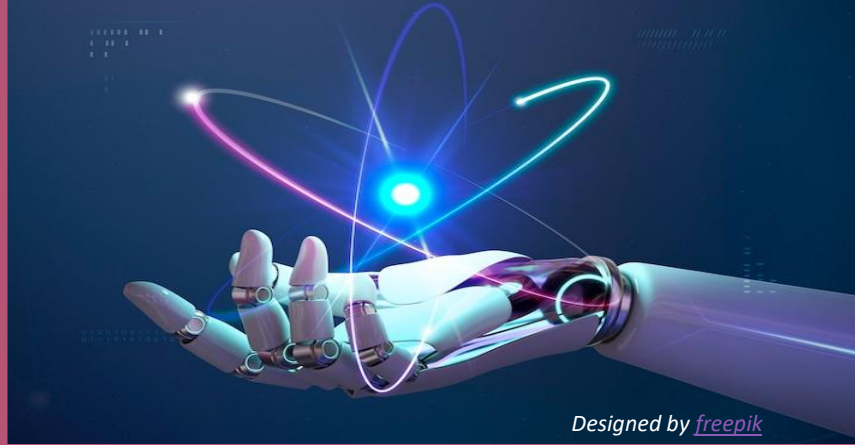
