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
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Australia opposes UNESCO endangered status for Barrier Reef

Canberra will oppose plans to add the Great Barrier Reef to the endangered UNESCO World Heritage site list. The Great Barrier Reef has been considered a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1981. Australia said Tuesday it plans to lobby against UN plans to add the Great Barrier Reef to a list of endangered UNESCO World Heritage sites. Conservation experts working with the UN warned on Monday that the world's largest coral reef would be added to the list of endangered World Heritage sites. But if the UN decides to designate the reef as endangered, it puts the Australian government on notice that the site could be removed from the World Heritage list altogether.

Nations for Snow Leopards Win Prestigious International Award for Biodiversity Conservation

(SEPTEMBER 22, 2022)

The BBVA Foundation's Biodiversity Conservation Awards honored Snow Leopard Trust with its Worldwide Award in recognition of its role in helping to create and support the Global Snow Leopard Ecosystem Protection Program (GSLEP), a first-of-its-kind alliance between 12 governments, conservationists, scientists and other organizations to work together for the conservation of the threatened snow leopard and its mountain ecosystems. Exact numbers are unknown, but it is believed that there may be as few as 4,000 and no more than 6,300 snow leopards left in the wild.

"Contract for building four SVL ships was signed between MoD and Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata on 30 October, 2018 for a total cost of ₹2435 crore.

SpaceX Cargo Dragon Docks to Space Station With Solar Arrays and Science Experiments

A SpaceX Dragon cargo spacecraft autonomously docked to the space-facing port of the International Space Station's Harmony module at 7:39 a.m. EST this morning, while the orbiting laboratory was traveling over the Pacific Ocean. NASA astronauts Nicole Mann and Josh Cassada monitored docking operations from the station. The Dragon launched on SpaceX's 26th contracted commercial resupply mission for NASA at 2:20 p.m. EST, Saturday, November 26, from Launch Complex 39A at the agency's Kennedy Space Center in Florida. The Dragon spacecraft will return to Earth with cargo and research after spending about one month attached to the space station.

PSLV-C54 successfully places earth observation satellite, 8 nanosatellites in orbit

In one of its longest missions, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) successfully placed nine satellites, including an Earth Observation Satellite (EOS-06) in multiple orbits with the help of the space agency's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV-C54). The vehicle took off precisely at 11.56 a.m. on Saturday from the first launch pad (FLP) at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC), SHAR. The eight nano satellites include ISRO Nano Satellite-2 for Bhutan (INS-2B)

FIFA WORLD CUP 2022: CHECK WHICH TEAMS QUALIFY FOR ROUND OF 16 IN QATAR

As the group matches of the FIFA World Cup 2022 in Qatar has finished, and now the round of 16 stage has come. Eight groups were created from the 32 participating teams in the Qatar 2022 World Cup, spanning from Group A to Group H, in the first phase. The top two teams from each group will proceed to the FIFA World Cup 2022 Round of 16, which marks the beginning of the knockout stages and features a single-headed round robin format in which each team plays the other once. France, who are the defending champions, became the first team to reach the Round of 16 after winning both of their group matches. They defeated Australia 4-1 whereas Les Bleus defeated Denmark. The Netherlands' campaign has been spearheaded in a similar way by Cody Gakpo, who has assisted them in moving on as the highly rated team from Group A and into the Round of 16. The winner of Group B, England, won the top spot in group with two victories and a draw. Christian Pulisic goal in the pivotal championship match against Iran helped the USA men's football team progress.
