A Game-Changer in Male Contraception: Researchers Identify Key Gene

(April 17, 2023)

Researchers at Washington State University have discovered a gene called Arrdc5, expressed in the testicular tissue of mice, pigs, cattle, and a highly effective, reversible, and non-hormonal male contraceptive for both humans and animals. The study found that when the gene was knocked out in mice, it caused infertility only in males by affecting sperm count, movement, and shape. The protein encoded by this gene is essential for normal sperm production, and the team is now working on designing a drug to inhibit its production or function. This approach avoids hormonal interference, a significant obstacle in male contraception.

Long COVID and Post-Flu Syndrome: A Surprising Similarity in Severity

(April 18, 2023)

Research in Queensland, Australia, indicates that long COVID's impact on health systems may be due to the volume of SARS-CoV-2 infections rather than symptom severity, as it has similar incidence and severity to seasonal influenza. The study has limitations, such as unmeasured factors and potential influence of vaccination or the Omicron variant on long COVID severity.

Artificial Intelligence Reveals a Stunning, High-Definition View of M87's Big Black Hole

Astronomers used machine learning to improve the Event Horizon Telescope's first black hole image, aiding in black hole behavior understanding and testing gravitational theories. The new technique, called PRIMO, has potential applications in various fields, including exoplanets and medicine. Astronomers have used machine learning to sharpen up the Event Horizon Telescope's <u>first picture of a black hole</u> — an exercise that demonstrates the value of artificial intelligence for finetuning cosmic observations.

The team developed a new imaging technique using PET scans with radioactive acetate and glucose probes to visualize the interaction between astrocytes and neurons in Alzheimer's patients.
