## Seventh Banksy Mural Spotted in London

Monday, August 12, 2024

A seventh animal painting by Banksy emerged in London over the weekend. This time the elusive street artist made a police box in the City of London look like **a fish tank**. Given the police's reaction, though, it looks like the authorities are running out of patience. "We are aware of criminal damage to a City of London Police box in Ludgate Hill," detective chief inspector Andy Spooner reportedly said. "We are liaising with the City of London Corporation who own the police box." The fish follow a mountain goat, a pair of elephants, three monkeys, two pelicans, and a wolf, all sprayed in various London locations.

## Nazi Artifacts Stolen

Monday, August 12, 2024

Harvard University will not remove the name Arthur M. **Sackler** from one of its three art museums and another campus building.

Recommendations in a recent report concluded an extended campaign by student activists aimed at distancing the Ivy League college from the family which owned Purdue Pharma.

In October 2022, the group Harvard College Overdose Prevention and Education Students submitted a 23-page proposal requesting the removal of Sackler's name. A committee comprised primarily of university administrators were not persuaded by the included arguments,

## IOA reaction on Vinesh Phogat's appeal verdict

IOA statement on Vinesh Phogat's appeal being dismissed: "(IOA president) PT Usha expresses shock and disappointment at the decision of the Sole Arbitrator at the CAS to dismiss wrestler Vinesh Phogat's application against the United World Wrestling (UWW) and the International Olympic Committee (IOC)."

"The operative part of the August 14 decision, which dismisses Vinesh's application to be awarded a shared silver medal in women's 50 kg category at the Paris Olympic Games has significant implications for her in particular and the sporting community at large," the IOA stated.

## More than 4 billion people may not have access to clean water

Thursday, August 15, 2024

Access to clean water is a human right — one that half of the world may not have.

Out of the roughly 8 billion people on Earth, more than 4.4 billion [lack access to safely managed drinking water](#), researchers report August 15 in *Science*. The estimate, based on computer simulations of data from low- and middle-income countries, is more than double [the figure calculated by the World Health Organization](#) (SN: 8/16/18).

## Scientists Find Strong Evidence For Liquid Water On Mars

The SSLV-D3, in its third and final development flight, lifted off from the first launch pad of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at 9.17 am.



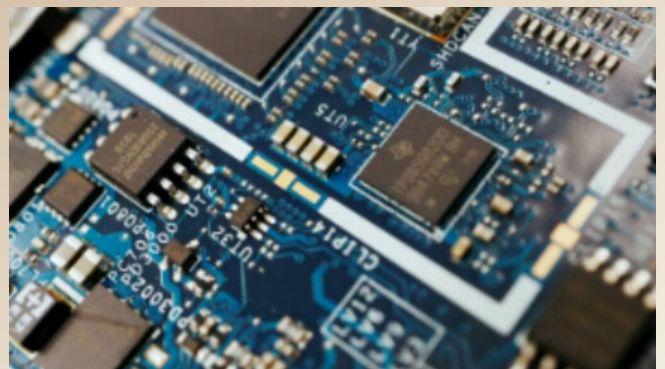
